

## HENSLEY TABLE LAMP





# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## HENSLEY TABLE LAMP

### WIRING CONNECTIONS

No wiring is required, just insert the polarized plug in the outlet & turn on the power when lamp assembly is finished

### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1 This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug outlet will fit in a polarized only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to defeat this safety features.
- 2 It is recommended to use 1 x 60 - Watt maximum Type A bulb.
- 3 To avoid the risk of fire, do not exceed the recommended wattage.
- 4 The manufacturer and distributor accept no liability for incorrect installation.
- 5 For indoor use only.

### WARNINGS:

When unpacking, be careful not to pull wire, as a bad connection may result. Do not connect electricity until your lamp is fully assembled. Do not touch or look directly at the bulb when lamp is illuminated.

### TO ASSEMBLE:

- 1 Stand lamp base on the flat surface
- 2 Remove the finial from center post, above the lamp base by rotating it Anti-clock wise
- 3 Insert 1 x 60 Watt Type A Bulb into the socket
- 4 Place the Shade on base center post. Gently tighten back the finial to affix the shade in place.
- 5 Insert the polarized plug in the outlet & turn on the power, to test the lamp
